Forward Exam:

3rd-5th grade got off to a great start last week with the forward exam. The teachers and para's did an awesome job of preparing the students and providing a quality testing environment to support all students. The Forward Exam results are used by the state to measure progress of 3-5th grade students as compared to their peers. These results typically come to us in June and when the school report cards are created.

MAP Testing:

We will begin MAP testing in early May for all students. Map testing is used to evaluate student growth in many curricular areas and is used by our team to assess the curriculum we teach and identify any gaps in learning that may exist. This year we will use MAP testing to evaluate growth of our students in many areas and use the information to guide our curriculum work and instruction for the next school year.

Parent Survey:

As part of our Continuous Improvement process we are creating an end of the year parent survey. This data will be used to help guide our strategic planning for the next two years and will be a critical piece of that work. We look forward to hearing about your ideas, concerns and any suggestions that you may have to help us grow this amazing school.
