#### Calendar

We are also working with the Department of Public instruction to insure that the academic calendar and school minutes align with all state guidelines. #### Department of Public Instruction monitoring

We recently received feedback from the state in terms of the DPI monitoring that took place in January. The report was extremely positive and they were impressed by the level of student, teacher and family engagement in the school. The report noted the sound fiscal policies and management in addition to the support provided by NOSD, Riveredge Nature Center and CESA 6 for management of the school.
