Families have been asking about the mask policy for the 2021-22 school year. In response to inquiries regarding our COVID policy and masks, here is the response taken from our <u>FAQs: Lottery and</u> <u>Enrollment 2021-22</u> website page.

"The 2020-21 COVID safety plan is available to review on our <u>website</u> under the menu "Family Resources" and "Current Students". Our safety protocols will remain in place for the remainder of the 2020-21 school year. This year students wear masks both indoors and outdoors. Students take distanced mask breaks and opportunities for mask breaks are provided at teachers' discretion or dependent upon the activity.

Any safety protocols, including wearing masks, will be discussed and ultimately approved by the Governance Council in consideration of the most current CDC guidelines and with guidance from the Washington Ozaukee Health Department over the summer, 2021.

In line with our mission and philosophy, in person instruction is a top priority to deliver the highest quality of instruction."
